Arrangements for pickup can be made through the church office. Please, no tires, clothes, TV's or computer peripherals.

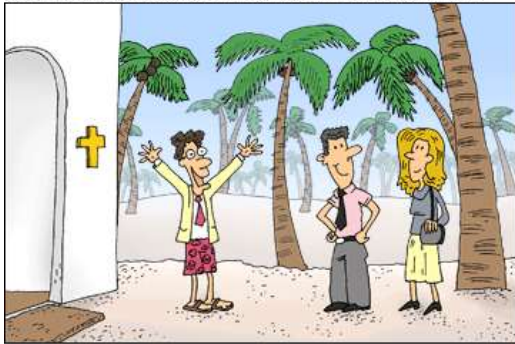
### Jiggs & Dinner
